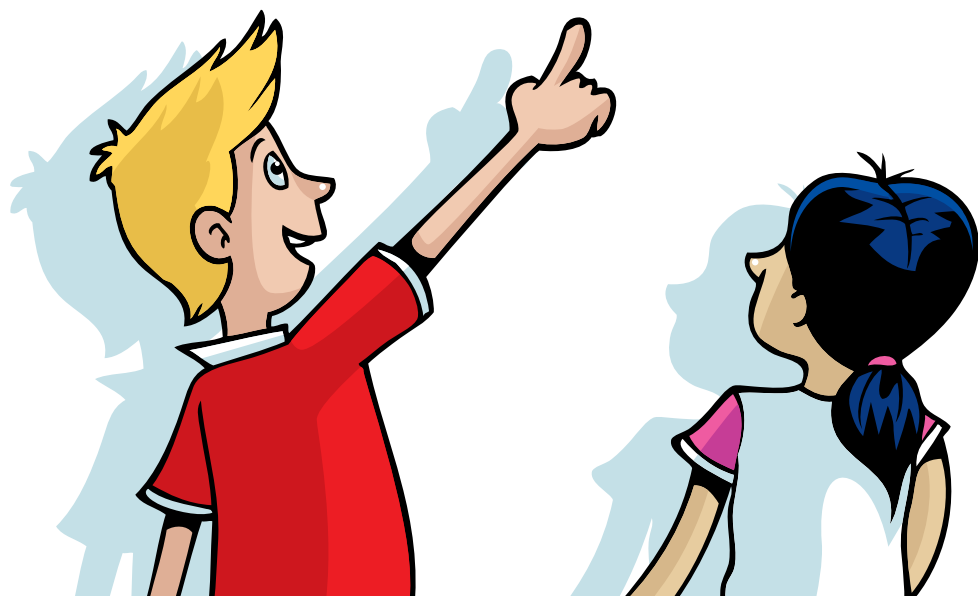

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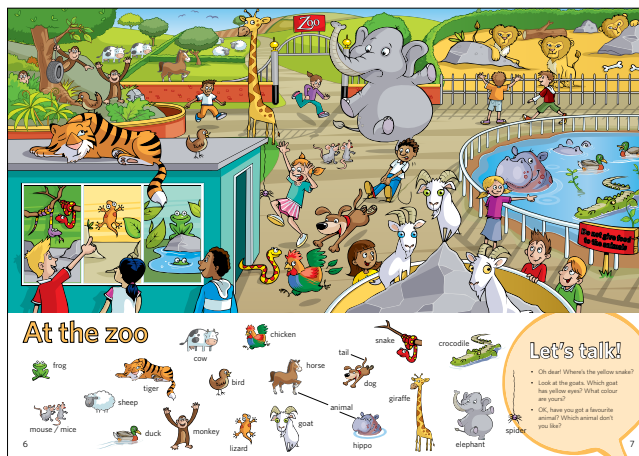


# About this book

What can they ask you to find in the pictures?

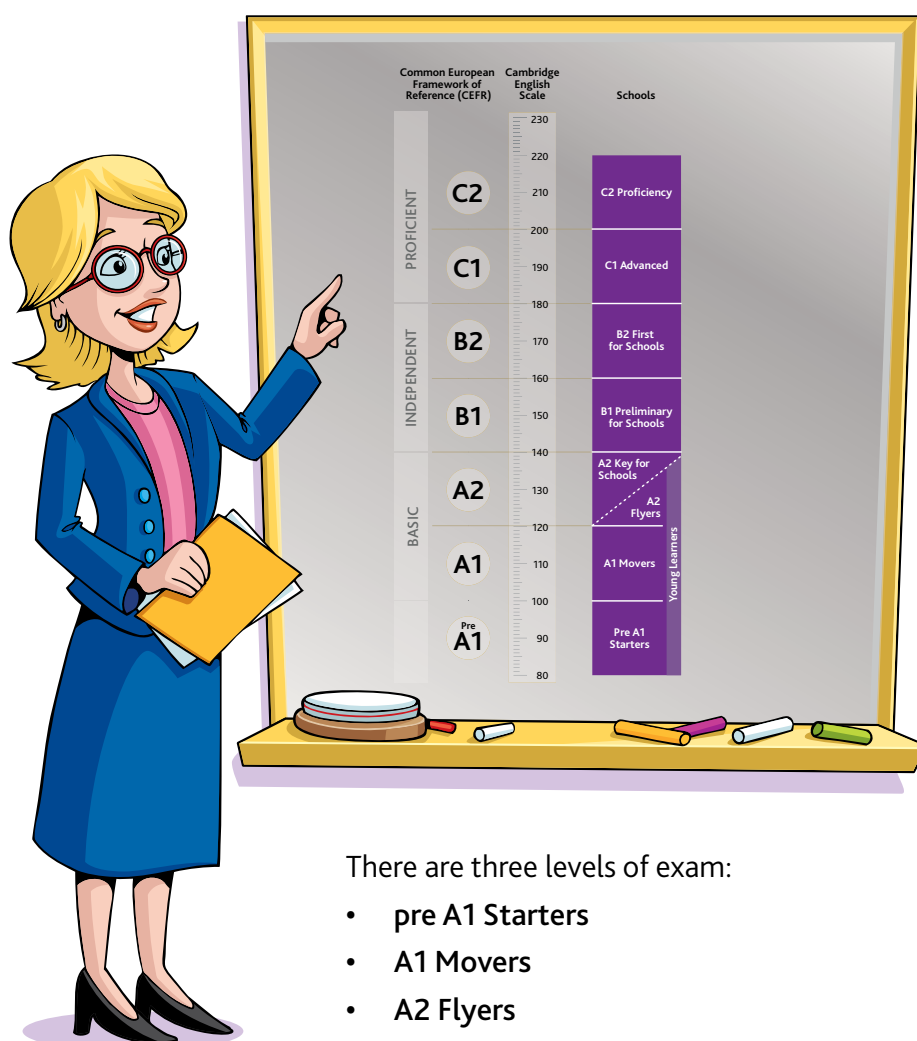
